
Dear Leslie:

Dear Judge Gonzales:

It has been announced that the President will be in Jackson, Mississippi, on August 7, to support the re-election of Representative Chip Pickering. It will not be appropriate for me to attend any of the political events, as much as I would like to see the President.

Details of the schedule have not been announced, but I am confident that President Bush will have little time available for anything that is unconnected to the focus of the trip. Still, I wish to extend him an invitation to retrace some literal steps that he took an earlier time that he was campaigning in Jackson. The year was 1988. He, Rhesa Barksdale and I went on a five-mile run through scenic areas of Jackson during a break from campaigning for G.H.W. Bush.

I have read of the President's running prowess. Seven minute miles are incredible. If I had a recent road race time to prove my bona fides, it would only show slightly under eight minute miles. At least I am persistent - over 1000 miles a year since 1990, in part to stay in shape for the annual physical fitness test in the National Guard.

If you may appropriately do so, I ask that you present my invitation for some executive exercise in Jackson. A Secret Service sanctioned course could be found, and I have some ideas of what might be acceptable. It will be hot and humid, but Texans are used to such. Perhaps a three mile journey would helpfully energize the Leader of the Free World while he is here.

Thank you for any assistance that you can give.

Dear Mr. President:

This is to ensure your awareness of two recent events in Hawaii and Afghanistan that I am sure you will agree represent the best of our country.

As you know, my Hawaii is ideally suited and dedicated to physical fitness. It is also home to a larger component of our country's armed forces, over 10,000 of whom are now serving in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Two major events on Hawaii's outdoor calendar are the Honolulu Marathon, reportedly the third largest marathon event worldwide, and the Great Aloha Run, an event attracting thousands of residents and visitors. This year, the organizers of both events teamed with our military to recognize our troops serving overseas, many of whom participate in these and other events when they are home in Hawaii, in organizing and conducting these events in Afghanistan as well.

Specifically, on December 11, 2004, Honolulu Marathon day, members of the 2nd Battalion, 5th Infantry Regiment, USA organized and completed the Honolulu Marathon - Afghanistan in the Tarin Kowt area of the country. And on January 30, 2005, Great Aloha Run day, the 25th Infantry Division (Light) Headquarters Company personnel organized the running of the Great Aloha Run - Afghanistan.

All 153 participants in the Honolulu Marathon - Afghanistan were treated like every finisher of the Marathon: each received the same medals, certificates and tee-shirts. An official timing system was flown in and the finishing times were placed on the Marathon's website along with all other finishers from the race in Honolulu. I would like to highlight the reaction of the winner of the Marathon, First Lieutenant Mike Baskin; he burst into tears as he remembered his four fellow soldiers who had recently been killed.

While only military personnel ran in each race, those who ran in the Great Aloha Run - Afghanistan endured sub-freezing temperatures and, more importantly, raised money for local Afghan charities, including an orphanage in downtown Kowst. Because of its shorter distance, the race was conducted in four separate locations throughout the country, including Bagram Airfield and Forward Operating Base Salerno.
