Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2014-0080-F[1] are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2014-0080-F[1] contains materials related to the possession of weapons of mass destruction (WMD) by Iraq.

The first segment of this FOIA primarily contains press releases, fact sheets, presidential and vice presidential remarks, pool reports, talking points (and drafts thereof), publications, news articles, and email correspondence with journalists that mention WMDs and Iraq. Additionally, there are routine policy-related poll results compiled from news sources, transcripts, draft

legislation, scheduling materials and meeting requests, congressional briefing schedules, and draft robo letters.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2014-0080-F[1] are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
