# **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2014-0333-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2014-0333-F requested materials related to emails within the George W. Bush administration regarding the revelation of memos regarding torture, as reported by the *New York Times, Washington Post, Wall Street Journal*, and *Newsweek* in June 2004.

This FOIA primarily contains news reports regarding the memos, transcripts of official administration statements, speeches, press appearances, and Congressional testimony about the memos, as well as talking points about the War on Terror.

# System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2014-0333-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
