Scope and Content

The materials in 2018-0015-P are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the request. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Request 2018-0015-P consists of emails Brett M. Kavanaugh was blind carbon copied on while he served as Associate Counsel and then as Senior Counsel in the White House Counsel's Office. These materials are from the Automated Records Management System (ARMS), Exchange Email, and RNC Personal Storage Table (PST) Search and Access Sets. The emails cover the time period from January 20, 2001 to July 6, 2003.

This request primarily consists of emails containing routine scheduling and administrative discussions, routine biographies and correspondence about eventual nominees, routine approval

memos for judicial nominees, emails containing news clips, routine correspondence with journalists and interest groups, routine information about court cases and pending legislation, congressional correspondence, talking points, and Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES) appointment request and acknowledgement emails.

System of Arrangement

The materials in 2018-0015-P are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the request. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this request were found in these collection areas – George W. Bush Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by President George W. Bush. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
