Abstract: These subject categories contain materials related to education. A significant portion of the materials in these files includes speech drafts, talking points, and publications about No Child Left Behind (NCLB).

Custodial History: Official records of George W. Bush's presidency are housed at the George W. Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Administrative History: The White House Office of Records Management is responsible for the filing and retrieval of records created during the incumbent presidential administration. The use of a filing methodology for records created or received by the White House dates to at least the early years of the 20th century, and has undergone changes since that time to cope with the everexpanding volume of paperwork handled by the President and his staff.

The White House Office of Records Management, or ORM (or WHORM) manages the office files of individual White House staff members, as well as administration records that are arranged by subject code and case file ID number according to their general subject matter.

Scope and Content Note: This subject category contains materials related to education. The materials from ED (Education) consist of memoranda, news clippings, correspondence, publications, proposed legislation, speeches (and drafts thereof), talking points, reports, and fact sheets. The correspondence present is between President George W. Bush, Congress, and the general public regarding George W. Bush administration education policy. Letters written to President George W. Bush by students as part of class projects including many expressing sympathies after September 11, 2001, are also present in these files, as are thank you notes from President George W. Bush following education events, and in response to letters of support for his initiatives. Memoranda, correspondence, and reports to President George W. Bush cover topics such as literacy, teacher education programs, affordable vocational and collegiate tuition, school choice, education funding, special education, violence in schools, educational opportunities for minority students, Title IX, higher education, civic education, and background information for school visits. A significant portion of the materials in these files covers the implementation of No Child Left Behind (NCLB) including memoranda from White House advisors. Talking points, publications, and reports on the results of NCLB are present as well.

Materials in ED001 (Libraries-Facilities) include agendas for education events, guest lists for National Book Festival events, and letters from students to President George W. Bush. The subject category ED002 (Scholarships/Fellowships/Grants) includes mainly correspondence such as drafts of congratulatory letters to recipients of the Presidential Freedom Scholarship, response letters to public mail on various education topics, and letters from Congress about education initiatives. Materials in ED003 (Teachers/Teaching Methods/Educational Programs) include speech drafts, fact sheets, and drafts thereof for the White House Conference on Preparing Tomorrow's Teachers and the 2006 National Teacher of the Year award presentation.

System of Arrangement: Material is arranged by alphanumeric subcode and thereunder by case file number.
