Dear Judge Gonzales:

This is in further reference to my letter dated February 4, 2003 providing you, on behalf of the incumbent President, with formal notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) of our intent to open 40 pages of Bush Vice Presidential records.

In accordance with the requirements of the Presidential Records Act (PRA), 44 U.S.C. §§ 2201-2207 and Executive Order 13233, we also informed former President Bush's representative, James W. Cicconi, and former President Reagan's representative, John Mintz, of our intent to release these records. We have subsequently been informed by both Mr. Cicconi and Mr. Mintz that they have no objection to the release of this material. Please note that the material proposed for opening in this notice includes 14 pages of documents containing confidential communications requesting or submitting advice and four pages containing information related to appointments to federal office that would normally have been withheld prior to January 20, 2001, under the PRA restrictions in 44 U.S.C. §2204(a), as they were asserted and narrowed by President Bush. A copy of these documents was provided to Brett Kavanaugh on February 4, 2003.

Pursuant to E.O. 13233, NARA will await a decision from the incumbent President regarding the release of these records. We look forward to hearing the views of the incumbent President regarding this notification as soon as possible, hopefully within 45 days of this letter, which would be July 5, 2003.
