

On behalf of the President and Judge Gonzales, I write in response to your letter of April 12 regarding the extraordinary caseload in the Southern District of California. As the President stated this past week when making his first circuit nominations, he is committed to filling the over 100 existing vacancies on the federal bench as quickly as possible, and he has urged the Senate to exercise its consent function promptly in light of the large number of vacancies. The Administration also is aware of the various proposals for additional judgeships in the Southern District of California and elsewhere and will respond to specific legislation at the appropriate time.


