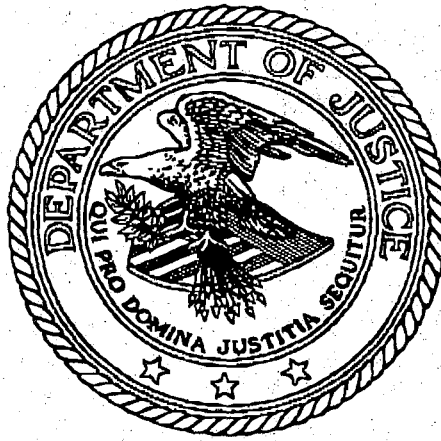


Dear Mr. Huff:

I am a reporter with Newsweek in the magazine's Washington bureau. I would like to request under the Freedom of Information Act copies of all documents-- including memoranda, analyses, correspondence, reviews, reports, etc.-- in the possession of the Department of Justice relating to the 1996 Anti-Terrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act. This should specifically include any written material relating to the habeas corpus provisions of that legislation, as well as other provisions relating to the government's efforts to combat international terrorism. It should also include all materials relating to testimony before Congress, communications with members of Congress and communications with the White House relating to this act. Proposals relating to habeas corpus had been before the Congress in earlier years and would have provoked reports, reviews, analyses, etc. within the department. I specifically request that these earlier documents be included within the scope of my request.

The request should include all documents within all components of DOJ, including the criminal division, the civil rights division, the office of Legislative Affairs, the office of the legal counsel, the Solicitor General's office, the executive office of U.S. attorneys, the deputy attorney general's office, the attorney general's office and any other component that might have documents responsive to this request.

Thank you very much for your assistance on this matter. Please feel free to call if you have any questions about the scope of this request or, alternatively, to advise me about when I can expect a response.
