#### **Extent**

105 folders, approximately 11,369 pages

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to George W. Bush Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 2201) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Provenance**

Official records of George W. Bush's presidency are housed at the George W. Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0186-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-0186-F requested the Staff Member Office Files of L. Ari Fleischer, White House Press Secretary from January 2001 to July 2003.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence and schedules. Schedules consist of Fleischer's daily schedule, however every date is not included. Correspondence consists of outgoing letters from Fleischer and incoming letters from members of the public, professional contacts, journalists, friends, congressman, and individuals Fleischer met through his position at the White House. Topics covered in the letters include Fleischer's performance as press secretary, policy ideas to share with President George W. Bush and other White House staff, interview requests

for President George W. Bush, and well wishes after meetings or travels. Also included are letters from the public congratulating Fleischer on his job in the White House, his engagement, and his marriage.

### **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0186-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
