This reply was coordinated with Corps, OMB, and CEQ:

The requested improvements on the Inner Harbor Navigation Canal will strengthen and improve hurricane and storm protection for greater New Orleans, and will be implemented in a way that does not place communities at greater risk. The President has requested \$350 million to improve hurricane and storm protection along the Inner Harbor Navigation Canal (IHNC).

The article you forwarded does not describe the Administration proposal with precision. Under our funding and authorization request, the Corps has the flexibility to improve protection either by upgrading the floodwalls along the length of the IHNC or by installing closure structures, one at Lake Pontchartrain and another on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW). The Administration's proposal would not support construction of a closure structure on the Mississippi River Gulf Outlet (MRGO); installing a closure structure anywhere along MRGO would entangle the IHNC improvement work with the highly controversial MRGO, whose future has not yet been decided.

Once Congress provides the requested supplemental funds for NOLA system improvements, the Corps will initiate modeling specific to the IHNC improvements and other proposed projects. The project modeling will help the Corps determine the most effective way to improve protection along the IHNC and will include analyzing potential risks such as any potential for increased backflow of water as a result of the installation of a closure structure. The Corps will incorporate the results of that modeling into the project design and would take measures necessary to address any identified risks.

The Corps will also engage local communities, including St. Bernard and Orleans parishes, to seek their input on the project design and to address concerns such as those you raised. The results of the modeling and the local information sessions, which will take about 3-4 months, will help inform the Corps decision on the best design for improving hurricane protection along the IHNC.

Karl:

I just read an article on the Times Picyune website that the President is pushing for money to construct gates at certain points of vulnerability to the city.

My point of concern is that they are talking about putting one of those gates on the MRGO WEST of Chalmette, which

means when the storm surge hits, the backflow is going to wipeout St. Bernard Parish.

The MRGO should be shut down altogether, since it does not justify its dredging investment by the Corps of Engineers. I know the shipping interests are obsessed with keeping it open despite the fact that it was the MRGO that sent 11 feet of water into my home.

But to build a gate west of St. Bernard is unfathomable. If the MRGO had to be kept open, the flood control gate should be built further east, linking it into St. Bernard's hurricane protection levee system in Verret.

Economically speaking, St. Bernard is home of two oil refineries that are back in operation. However, with that west gate nobody in their right mind is going to want to move back to St. Bernard. I hope the President will reconsider the placement of that gate and seek input from local leaders about something that will doom what's left of St. Bernard.
