This FOIA primarily contains master tape video recordings from the White House Television Office (WHTV) related to the arrival and remarks by President George W. Bush during the “Maine Welcome” event on October 22, 2002, at the Bangor International Airport. WHTV 1733 has a run time of 00:40:44 and shows President George W. Bush arriving on stage and delivering

remarks at the Welcome Maine event on October 22, 2002 at the Bangor International Airport – Hangar 12.
