Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0309-F requested classified records from the United States Trade Representative regarding Nicaragua trade policy, economic policy, and diplomatic relations.

This FOIA primarily contains unclassified trade advisory committee reports regarding the United States-Central America Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA) submitted to Congress, the United States Trade Representative, and the President, report transmittal letters, cover sheets, and various documents relating to the approval of a travel request.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2016-0309-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
