### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0424-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-0424-F requested materials related to the final transition staffing memo that would have been sent by White House Chief of Staff Josh Bolten in late 2008 to all political appointees in the George W. Bush administration instructing them to submit letters of resignation before the incoming administration of Barack Obama.

This FOIA primarily contains a barcode scanning sheet, charts listing the Cabinet, Executive Office of the President, and Sub-Cabinet Agencies, and handwritten notes containing routine filing and routing instructions.

### **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0424-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files.
