Biographical History: Kristin Henderson was a Deputy Associate Director from May 2007 until January 2009 in the White House Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives. While working at the White House, Mrs. Henderson updated the OFBCI website, compiled and edited OFBCI reports, participated in the Compassion in Action Roundtables, and assisted in other OFBCI conferences. Her material also contains records from other OFBCI staff members that were retired by Kristin Henderson at the end of the administration.

Kristin Henderson attended Patrick Henry College. Prior to her work at the White House, she was a legislative assistant for the U.S. House of Representatives.

Scope and Content Note: This series is divided into 15 subseries.

General Files contains reports, publications, agendas, fact sheets, correspondence and drafts thereof. These materials consist of newsletters, conference information and packets, reports and publications, memoranda and drafts thereof, contact lists and presentations. Many of these materials relate to OFBCI Conferences and Compassion in Action Roundtables, including travel authorizations and receipts. In addition, there are grants catalogs, grant award charts by state, state liaison contact lists, work plans, and Federal Agency CFBCI (Center for Faith-Based and Community Initiatives) reports. Correspondence includes thank you letters to OFBCI, congratulatory letters from George W. Bush, and background materials on organizations sent to OFBCI.

Outreach Organization Contact Files consists of correspondence sent in to the White House from organizations. This material was retired by Kristin Henderson but used by Jennifer Sullivan and contains notes and responses from many different staff members within the OFBCI office. Correspondence includes inquiries concerning grant opportunities, scheduling requests for staff and the President, invitations to events, requests for Presidential Messages, requests for information about the Office and the initiatives, and general informational materials about organizations.

Outreach Conference Files contains background materials in preparation for OFBCI national and regional conferences, including conference documents such as handouts, packets, and agendas, hotel maps and information sheets, agendas, invitations, talking points, presentations, statements of work, budgets, surveys, and drafts thereof. Also included are travel information, organization brochures and reports, articles, schedules, OFBCI correspondence with outside organizations, conference vendors, and contractors, and correspondence within OFBCI and with CFBCIs. This material was also retired by Kristin Henderson but used by Jennifer Sullivan and other OFBCI staff members.

Dungeon Files includes agency reports from their own FBCI offices, data collection surveys, academic papers, news articles, and scheduling forms. The subseries also includes letters from the public in support of legislation related to faith-based and community initiatives; charitable foundation literature, annual reports, and success stories; and conference planning documents and conference participant handouts. Topics present include CARE (Charity Aid, Recovery, and Empowerment) Act, CCF (Compassion Capital Fund), Charitable Choice, CNCS (Corporation for National and Community Service), and agency studies and audits on federal funding for charities.
