Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2017-0196-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2017-0196-F requested photographs of Dan Coats, U.S. Ambassador to Germany.

This FOIA primarily contains photographs of routine arrivals and departures in Germany, featuring President George W. Bush, Mrs. Laura Bush, Jenna Bush, Ambassador Dan Coats and his wife, Marsha Coats. Also pictured are events from a 2002 trip to Germany, including meetings and a working lunch with Chancellor Gerhard Schroeder, Foreign Minister Joschka Fischer and staff and a U.S. embassy greeting. Events pictured in Washington, D.C., include a National Security Council pre-brief and lunch with Chancellor Gerhard Schroeder of Germany on February 27, 2004 and a meeting between Judge Samuel Alito, President George W. Bush

and Ambassador Dan Coats in the hall of the EEOB on December 2, 2005. Also depicted are President George W. Bush, Judge Samuel Alito, his wife Martha Alito, and White House Counsel staff watching the final Senate confirmation vote on Judge Alito as Supreme Court Associate Justice from the Roosevelt Room of the White House on January 31, 2006.
