FOIA 2017-0207-F requested records from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) related to Sergey Kislyak.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence, contact information, printed emails, briefings, schedules, copies of autographed photos, and other routine administrative documents. A significant quantity of the request consists of draft and final thank you letters from President George W. Bush to various individuals that he met with in Russia as well as background

information used to prepare those letters. A briefing, guest list, and numerous grip-and-grin photos of the 2008 Iftaar Dinner are included because Kislyak attended the event.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 2017-0207-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.
